President Larry Hicks called the fall meeting of the KSSA to order at 10:20 am at the Capitol City Gun Club.

The minutes were read by Bob Thornton and approved.

The treasurers' report was given by Bob Thornton and was approved.

Whitney Damron presented the proposed changes to the KSSA By-Laws. After discussion it was decided to allow the directors a chance to read and respond back to Whitney electronically by Dec. 15, 2005.

State teams requirements were clarified to be a completion all four events in two of the four state shoots, and a minimum of five-hundred targets in the twelve, twenty, twenty-eight, and four-ten, and three hundred targets in the doubles.

A motion was made and passed to require shoot managers to make available to the web-master all of the pertinent information for registration of the four major shoots thirty days prior to the shoot. Further more it was highly recommended that this information be made available for all shoots to the web-master. It was also highly recommended that all shoot managers report scores of all shoots to the web-manager.

A motion was made and passed to allow the Treasurer to change the existing Cap Fed account to a Certificate of Deposit and to move the working account to make the best use of the account for the KSSA.

The KSSA shoot schedule was set.

Brunner Range will hold a NSSA Level 1 instructors course June 17/18, 2006.

Larry requested suggestions for the state team awards to be made to him by the spring meeting.

Larry Hicks presented Brad Goodart's slate of officers by proxy. The slate consisted of the existing officers President Larry Hicks, Vice-President Brad Goodart, and Sec./Trea. Bob Thornton. The slate was re-elected unopposed.

Motion was made and passed to adjourn
